Third step is to draw the floor plan and flip the entrance to the other side of the building and arrange some furniture.



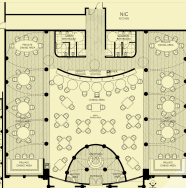
Fourth step was to draw stairs to the second floor because the plan was including two stories building.

Sixth step was pulling back the room area all the way to the back wall and create more room to make it easy to the employees and customers to move around the restaurant.

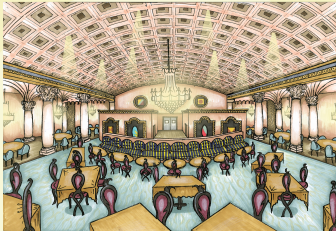


The seventh step in my floor plan, is fixing the busy road floor, arranging the furniture in a better economical way and creating an extra emergency exit from the back of the restaurant.
